### Winemaking

Traditional fermentation is carried out over 10 days at a controlled temperature in steel tanks. ### Our tasting note

The Pinot Nero has a clear and fresh ruby-red colour. A fruity interplay of aromas between beetroot, cherry and raspberry, as well as a tangy note with a pinch of white pepper are what characterise the nose of this wine. This wine captures the palate with a juicy structure and inviting freshness, with soft, smooth tannins, subtle tanginess in the background as well as with a youthfully elegant finish.
